Tom Drummond studied mathematics at Cambridge University for his first degree before emigrating to Australia in 1990. He worked for CSIRO in Melbourne until 1994 when he went to Perth to do his PhD in Computer Science at Curtin University. He then returned to the UK to undertake post-doctoral research in Computer Vision at Cambridge University and was appointed a permanent lectureship in 2002. In September this year, he took up a professorship at Monash University. His research interests include real-time computer vision, visually guided robotics, augmented reality, robust methods and SLAM.
